



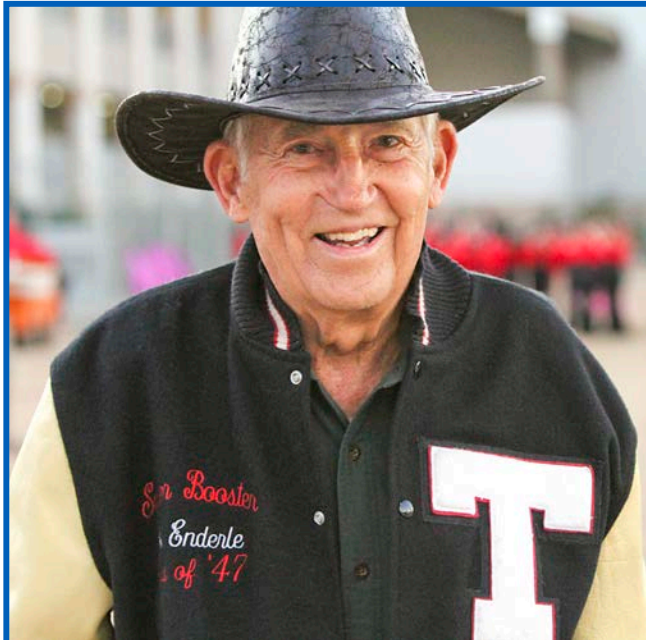

TACFA HONORS AL ENDERLE

When it comes to supporting the Arts in Tustin, nobody does it better than Enderle Center! For many years, this community has been blessed by the generosity of Mr. Al Enderle. Al recognizes the importance of giving back to a community and understands the value of bringing culture to the City of Tustin.

Al grew up in Orange County and graduated from Tustin High in 1947, earning his Eagle Scout award that same year. Mr. Enderle went on to Stanford University and graduated from the U. S. Naval Academy in Annapolis in 1952. After serving in the Navy, Al married and began raising a family. As life



moved forward, Al became dedicated and passionate about serving the community with a special interest in children, education and the arts. Reaching out, he became a Founding Board member of the Boys and Girls Club of Tustin; he joined the Tustin Policing Committee, the Grace Bible Mission Board, Assn. of Naval Aviators and became an honorary member of the Santa Ana-Tustin Kiwanis Club after 36 years. In 1984, Al Enderle implemented the "Teacher of the Year" and "Teacher of the Month" programs in the Tustin Public Schools. Not only did Al support education but, he learned to appreciate the arts and the impact they have on a child's development. Because of his outstanding service, Mr. Enderle was awarded "2008 Tustin Man of the Year," an honor well deserved by a man who had made significant contributions in a volunteer capacity to his community and the City of Tustin.

Today Enderle Center is one of the most desirable shopping centers in Orange County featuring specialty restaurants and exquisite shops. The Center was built in 1978 and named after the Enderle family who came to Orange County in the late 1800s! Enderle Center is the site of various community events, including many art programs during the year. The Spring Swing comes to town with the Laguna Swing Band Society. They feature a Summer Music Series and during the month of October four high school choirs perform at the Center. We can't forget the wonderful Holiday Open House right before Thanksgiving, showcasing a variety of music and dance performances. A man of deep faith and a friend to everyone, Al will most likely greet you at an Enderle event with a smile and welcoming hug!

For many years, TACFA has been a benefactor of Al Enderle's appreciation for the Arts. Since the beginning, Enderle Center has been a major sponsor for Broadway in the Park, the Tustin Area Council for Fine Arts' signature program. The center's financial support allows TACFA to keep ticket prices affordable for everyone in the community. Additionally, it is a major advertiser, ticket sponsor, and generously provides beautiful gift baskets for our opportunity prize drawings. Several businesses from Enderle Center contribute gift cards and home decor items to complete these coveted gift baskets. 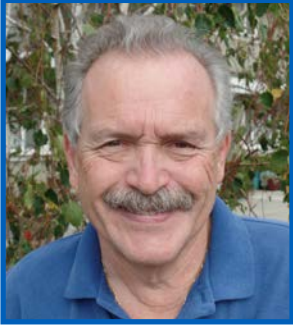

Art Education in the Tustin Schools



TACFA is very proud to announce that we are helping all 10 of the Title 9 Schools in the Tustin Unified School District with FIBO, an Art Education Program. All the children in each school, K-5, attend 3 assemblies during the school year. Each assembly introduces a different artist. These are not lectures, but interaction with animation, videos, pop music and dancing. This school year, the artists featured are Albrecht Durer, Winslow Homer and Georgia O'Keefe. Following each Art History Assembly, certified instructors teach a project inspired by the artist from the assembly to each class at the school. The classes are a great supplement to a school's curriculum.
